Regular Park Advisory Board meeting was opened by Mrs. Lorraine Gould.

Upon motion by Mr. Otis Sampson, seconded by Mr. Jeff Parks and carried unanimously, minutes of the August 24, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

Mrs. Gould will contact Acme for details on the bench they are donating. Park Board voted to have Mrs. Gould decide on which park the bench will be placed.

Mrs. Gould is to make sure a copy of the RTC Park master plan is forwarded to the Town Council with the recommendation from the Park Advisory Board to precede with the overall concept.

A piece of play equipment was destroyed by fire in Waylands Park on Saturday, September 19, 2015. A new volcano climb will need to be ordered and replaced back in the park. Mrs. Gould will stay in contact with the police department as their investigation is continuing.

Idewild and Moton Park gazebo/pavilions along with the parks themselves are getting a lot of use.

Mrs. Gould requested the Board let her know if there are improvements or action needed to be taken in any of the parks.

The Park Board advised Mrs. Gould to proceed with the “This is a Smoke Free Environment” signs to go in all of the parks. The sign is to be visible and posted with existing park rules.

Bark in the Park will be October 10, 2015 in Idlewild Park.

There will be a fashion show in Thompson Park on October 29, 2015 from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm. This event is sponsored by the Easton Business Alliance.

Michael Brophy was sworn in today by Mayor Willey as a member of the Town of Easton Park Advisory Board. His term will be through 2018.
