Regular Park Board meeting brought to order by Mr. Weise. Upon motion by Mr. McFadden seconded by Mr. Brophy and carried unanimously, minutes of the April 23, 2017 Park Board meeting was approved.

Items from Director of Parks and Recreation and members of the Park Advisory Board:

- 1) Mrs. Gould shared a "thank you" letter from Mr. John Franke, on behalf of the Friends of Easton Dog Park. Mr. Franke is the Vice President of the Friends of Easton Dog Park. The Easton Elks Club is now coordinating with the Friends to establish the dog park on the Elks property.
- 2) Mrs. Gould received a message from Dr. L. Cook. He is interested in possible upgrade to the skate park. He will be gathering information and is planning to share it with her when he has the information.
- 3) Easton Little League ordered a new batting net for the sports complex. Public Works has scheduled to put it up next Monday.
- 4) Pavilion scheduling in the parks is going well. Still have a concern of vehicular traffic and parking at the pavilion in Moton Park. There is a sign at the entrance of the park, it is on the general rules which is attached to the park use permit and written on the park use permit. "Parking is to be in designated spaces only."
- 5) Field usage and scheduling is going well also.
- 6) Due to weather conditions, the Multicultural Festival was moved from Idlewild Park to the middle school.

- 7) A blown light bulb was the problem with the field lights on Anthony Field at the sports complex. Mrs. Gould was in contact with Musco Lighting concerning the outage and they made contact and sent the proper bulb to American Sign in Delaware who came to do the repair.
- 8) Mrs. Gould had Fluharty Electric repair the underground break at the sports complex. The break was near the concession stand and under the asphalt. Anthony Field scoreboard can now be used.
- 9) Brian Femi/Town of Easton baseball camp registration is now underway. Registration and payments will be taken at the Town of Easton. The first camp is scheduled to begin June 12th.
- 10) The Park Advisory Board has asked Mrs. Gould to look into the possibility of placing a trash can on the Rail Trail near the area of C. Albert Matthews. Seem to be a significant amount of trash on the ground in that area.

Next Park Advisory Board meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 26, 2017 at noon.
