Regular Park Advisory Board meeting brought to order by Mr. Weise. Upon motion by Mr. Parks, seconded by Mr. Brophy and carried unanimously, minutes of the January 27, 2020 meeting were approved.

Items from the Town Engineer, Director of Parks and Recreation and members of the Park Advisory Board:

- 1) Park and Recreation staff will continue aerating the fields at the Sports Complex. Will continue and hit the worn areas especially hard on the multi-purpose (rectangle) fields.
- 2) Mr. Van Emburgh advised members of the Park Advisory Board that Mid Shore Community Foundation will receive all money for the lights and will take care of paying Musco. Letters will go out to civil entities for donations. A one page flyer is needed to get the word out and Mr. Van Emburgh will take care of it.
- 3) The Town is still exploring options of placing a building at the Sports Complex to replace the sheds that are being used for storage.
- 4) Continuing to move forward with the dog park. A conceptual plan is needed.
- 5) Town of Easton is moving forward with fixing the fencing to the bottom of the tennis courts in Idlewild Park and the backstop fence in Idlewild and Matthewstown Run parks.
- 6) Mrs. Gould received a request from a Mulberry Station resident to place a volleyball net in Mulberry Station Park. Park Advisory Board thought it would be good to place a volleyball net in the park. Mrs. Gould will proceed.

Next meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 23, 2020 at noon.
