1. **Neglect of a Minor:** On October 1, 2015 Easton Police served a Criminal Summons on Walfredo Mendez Ramirez, 34, of East Dover Street in Easton. The summons formally charges Ramirez with one count of Neglect of a Minor (Child). The charges are a result of an event that occurred on 08-25-15 wherein an Easton Police Department Police Officer saw a 2 year old child wandering all by them self near the street in the area of Super Soda Gas Station on East Dover Street. The officer secured the child and eventually found the parents who were unaware that the child was missing. Police found one of those parents to be Ramirez and police would later apply for charges on both parents. Ramirez signed for his copies of the charging document and he was released on his signature pending trial in this matter.
2. **Denial of Essential Services:** On 10-01-15 Easton Police served a Criminal Summons on Doug Sanders of Pierce Way in Easton that formally charges him with Denying Essential Services to a Tenant. The summons is a result of matter that took place on July 14, 2015, wherein Sanders allegedly had power turned off at a residence that he owns in Baltimore City. According to the application for charges by the tenant Sanders turned off the power to the residence without proper authorization to do so. Sanders signed for his copy of the summons and he was released on his signature pending trial in this matter.
